#### **TUE, OCT 8 - ARRIVE ROME/ASSISI**

Arrive Rome today where you will be met and transferred to Assisi, the famous city of St. Francis. Born in 1182 as Giovanni di Bernardone, the legacy of St. Francis influenced religion and culture around the world. Drive through the mystical province of Umbria stopping in Orvieto enroute (time permitting). (D)



#### WED, OCT 9 - ASSISI

This morning your walking tour includes the Basilica of St. Francis, still surrounded today by ancient walls, the Church of St. Clare and Santa Maria degli Angeli with its 'thornless rose bush'. The balance of the day is at leisure.

#### THU, OCT 10 - ASSISI/CASCIA/LANCIANO

Depart Assisi and drive south to Cascia to visit the Basilica of St. Rita. Continue to Lanciano where you will visit The Eucharistic Miracle. Overnight in the Lanciano area. (B,D)

#### FRI, OCT 11 - LANCIANO /MONTE SANT'ANGELO/ SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

Drive south along the Adriatic coast to visit the Sanctuary of St. Michael the Archangel (Santuario di Michele Arcangelo), a sacred cave and popular Catholic shrine near San Giovanni Rotondo. Here the Archangel Michael is said to have appeared in 490, 492 and 1656 and consecrated the shrine himself. Continue to nearby San Giovanni Rotondo. This afternoon see the places associated with Saint Pio, the room and confessional as well as the Shrine of Our Lady of Grace which houses the tomb of Saint Pio. (B,D)

#### SAT, OCT 12 - SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO/ SORRENTO AREA

This morning depart for the town of Sorrento. Perched along a hillside, Sorrento has sweeping views of the Bay of Naples and the famed Mount Vesuvius and is regarded as one of the most scenic towns in Italy. Balance of your day is free. Overnight in Sorrento area. (B,D)

#### **SUN, OCT 13 - SORRENTO AREA**

Full day at leisure to explore the many activities available in the Sorrento Area. (B)



#### MON, OCT 14 - SORRENTO/MONTE CASSINO/ROME

Depart this morning and drive north along the Autostrada del Sole speedway to the Benedictine Abbey of Monte Cassino, founded in AD 529 by Benedict of Nursia. Set high upon a hill overlooking the town of Cassino, the Monastery was rebuilt after heavy bombardment in World War II. On to the Eternal City of Rome. Located in the center of the Region of Lazio, Rome is a reflection of every era. The wonders of Rome surround you...a world of art, history and culture that has been attracting visitors since the beginning of Western civilization. This evening enjoy an Evening Illumination Tour. (B)

#### TUE, OCT 15 - ROME

Your sightseeing tour this morning takes you to Vatican City including visits to the Vatican Museum and Gallery and the Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo's magnificent frescoes. End your morning tour at the Basilica of St. Peter. This afternoon tour the Basilicas of St. Mary Major, St. John Lateran and St. Paul's outside the Walls. (B)

#### WED, OCT 16 - ROME - PAPAL AUDIENCE

This morning attend an Audience with Our Holy Father, Pope Francis.
