DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

MON, MAR 31, 2025 - ARRIVE MEXICO CITY

Fly today to Mexico City, a huge, sprawling metropolis with an exciting combination of Aztec, Spanish colonial and modern art and architecture. It is one of the world's most populous and is considered to be a world-class city.

TUE, APR 1 - MEXICO CITY

This morning you will enjoy a panoramic city tour that includes the Plaza of the Three Cultures to see the font where Juan Diego was baptized, the Zocalo, the Metropolitan Cathedral and the National Palace from the outside. This afternoon you drive to the floating gardens of Xochimilco for a gondola ride through the canals.

WED, APR 2 - MEXICO CITY – GUADALUPE/TEOTIHUACAN

Today you visit the impressive complex and one of Mexico's holiest shrines. This is where the Virgin of Guadalupe is said to have appeared to St. Juan Diego and honors her request that a Shrine be built in Her honor. Visit the New Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe that houses the sacred Tilma (image of the Virgin). Later, see the old Basilica, Tepeyac Hill and the surrounding gardens.

In the afternoon, drive northeast to one of the bestpreserved ancient cities in Mexico, the archaeological ruins of Teotihuacan. Teotihuacan was the most



important city in
North America
around 500 A.D.
The mile-long
Avenue of the
Dead is framed
by countless
monumental
structures,

including the pyramids of the Sun and Moon. (B,D)

THU, APR 3 - MEXICO CITY – PUEBLA/TLAXCALA/OCOTLAN

Depart this morning for Puebla, located about 60 miles southeast of Mexico City and Mexico's fourth largest city packed with ornate churches. Here is a showplace of Spanish colonial architecture; much of it adorned with the beautiful hand painted Talavera tiles for which the region is famous. Visit the Cathedral and the Rosary Chapel with its stunning tiled and gold-leafed walls. Continue to Tlaxcala, the "Lourdes" of Mexico and the Shrine of San Miguel del Milagro, site of the miraculous apparitions of St. Michael the Archangel to Diego

Lazaro de San Francisco in 1631. Visit the church and drink the healing water given curative powers by St. Michael himself. Stop in Ocotlan to see the beautiful Basilica and image of Our Lady that was miraculously burned into the wood after her appearance in 1532 to Juan Diego Bernardino and then return to Mexico City and your hotel. (B,D)

FRI, APR 4 - MEXICO CITY/TAXCO

Just two hours from Mexico City, in the State of



Guerrero, lies the historic town of Taxco, one of the most amazing towns in all of Mexico and world renowned for its beautiful colonial architecture and its narrow, cobbled streets. Located in the heart of the country between Acapulco and Mexico City, today Taxco is Mexico's top silver center. In fact, here you will find over 500 silver shops to entice you. On the way back to Mexico City, time permitting, stop in Cuernavaca. World famous for its year-round spring-like climate, Cuernavaca was the holiday choice of Aztec kings long before the Spanish conquest. (B,D)

SAT, APR 5 - MEXICO CITY

Today is leisure in this fabulous metropolitan city. Catch up on your last-minute shopping, sample the local cuisine or take a stroll along the tree-lined boulevards, looking at the various monuments. In the afternoon take the opportunity to check out Chapultepec Park, not only the city's largest park, but home to one of the finest museums, the National Anthropology Museum. Lastly, why not visit La Zona Rosa, a neighborhood popular for shopping, dining and nightlife. (B)

SUN, APR 6 - MEXICO CITY/PHOENIX
