YOUR DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

MON, NOV 3 - ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

Depart the United States on board your overnight transatlantic jet flight, arriving the following day.

TUE, NOV 4 - ARRIVE PRAGUE

Arrive today in historic capital of Prague, one of the most beautiful capitals in Europe. Transfer to your hotel where the balance of the day is at leisure. **(D)**

WED, NOV 5 - PRAGUE

This morning experience the 1000-year-old history of the city with a visit of Hradcany Castle, the seat of power for several Czech princes and Kings. Proceed to the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral, the picturesque Golden Lane, the Romanesque Basilica of St. George and Mala Strana (Lesser Town), which is full of winding streets lined with little taverns and old houses. Continue to Old Town to see the ancient Town Hall with its animated astronomical clock. Also see the Infant Jesus of Prague statue at Our Lady of Victory Church. **(B)**

THU, NOV 6 - PRAGUE/VIENNA

Cross the border into Austria, passing through Jihlava and Znoimo and continue on to Vienna, a metropolis in which the history of Europe has been uniquely documented. The city itself contains more than a million inhabitants and is set in beautiful surroundings.



FRI, NOV 7 - VIENNA

This morning enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vienna beginning with a drive around the Ringstrasse, one of the most magnificent boulevards in the world. It encloses the Inner City and such noble edifices as the Votive Church, built in 1856, the University, the City Hall and the Opera House. Continue to Schönbrunn Palace with its glorious French Park. The Palace has 1400 rooms and halls, a small zoo and a fine museum of state coaches. Your afternoon is at leisure for shopping or exploring on your own. **(B)**

SAT, NOV 8 - VIENNA/BRATISLAVA/BUDAPEST

Drive to Bratislava, capital of Slovakia, at the foothills of the Carpathian Mountains. Free time to see the magnificent gothic cathedral of St. Martin, site of the coronation of many Hungarian kings and queens. On to magnificent Budapest. The most cosmopolitan city in Eastern Europe, Budapest is known as the "Queen of the Danube." The ancient city, Buda, on the right bank of the Danube, and the modern city, Pest, on the left bank, are connected by a series of seven bridges. **(B,D)**

SUN, NOV 9 - BUDAPEST

Morning sightseeing begins at Heroes Square, decorated by several impressive statues. Continue to the old inner city of Pest then proceed to the remains of Buda Castle, Fisherman's Bastion, and scenic Gellert Hill, offering panoramic views of the entire city. **(B)**

MON, NOV 10 - BUDAPEST/KRAKOW

Leaving Hungary's enchanting capital today, you continue across the border to Krakow, Poland's ancient capital and once home to Polish kings. (B,D)

TUE, NOV 11 - KRAKOW/WADOWICE/KRAKOW

Medieval Krakow was Poland's only major city to escape massive destruction in World War II. Enjoy an orientation tour of the city. View St. Mary's Church and the Old Town. In the afternoon, travel to the town of Wadowice, the birthplace of Saint Pope John Paul II. On your return to Krakow, stop to visit the Shrine of Divine Mercy, built in honor of Sr. Faustina. **(B)**

WED, NOV 12 - KRAKOW/AUSCHWITZ/CZESTOCHOWA This morning drive to the Auschwitz Concentration Camp — a frightening reminder of the Holocaust. Then

on to Czestochowa, renowned for the Jasna Gora Monastery, which twice withstood the onslaught of overwhelming Swedish forces during the religious wars of the 17th



century, and the Black Madonna, the "Queen of Poland" which has become the country's national symbol. Overnight in the charming Czestochowa. (B,D)

THU, NOV 13 - CZESTOCHOWA/WARSAW

Today drive north to Warsaw. Though all but destroyed during World War II, Warsaw is a living monument to the spirit of its people. Today visit the lovingly restored Old Town is a symbol of the Poles determination to preserve their heritage. It is the true heart of the city, dating from the 14th century, and combines a mixture of Renaissance and Baroque buildings. Here you will walk along the cobbled streets and visit the beautiful Market Square. Other highlights include Chopin's Monument and the Warsaw Ghetto. **(B,D)**

FRI, NOV 14 - WARSAW/PHOENIX

Your journey is over as you board your flight back to the U.S.A., arriving Phoenix the same day. (B)
