Pay your respects at Jallianwala Bagh, a memorial for those affected by the tragic 1919 event. Explore the vibrant local markets in the evening and indulge in Amritsar's delicious cuisine before dinner at your hotel. Enjoy a restful night in this enchanting city!

DAY 7: AMRITSAR TO AGRA VIA DELHI

After breakfast, board the Vande Bharat Express, India's fastest train, for a scenic journey from Amritsar to Delhi. This modern train, known for its speed and comfort, offers a glimpse of the countryside as it passes through Punjab's golden wheat fields and Haryana's lush green landscapes. Upon arrival in Delhi, embark on a 4-hour drive to Agra, the city of love and legacy. After checking into your hotel, you can relax or explore the vibrant local markets in the evening. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Agra.

DAY 8: EXPLORING AGRA

Today, visit Badalgarh Fort, a lesser-known site offering panoramic views of Agra. Built by Raja Badal Singh, this fort predates the Mughal era. Built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his wife Mumtaz Mahal, it stands as a symbol of love. After breakfast, transfer to Delhi airport for your flight to Kolkata. Check in and enjoy dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Kolkata.

DAY 10: KOLKATA

Today, visit Mother Teresa's House and Tomb, where her humble living quarters and final resting place show her profound impact. Then, explore the Indian Museum, the oldest and largest in India, featuring ancient sculptures and rare artifacts. Conclude the day at the stunning Victoria Memorial, honoring Queen Victoria, surrounded by beautiful gardens. Dinner at the hotel and overnight in Kolkata.

DAY 11: KOLKATA TO CHENNAI

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Chennai, the cultural gateway to South India. Visit San Thome Basilica, built over the tomb of St. Thomas the Apostle, known for its stained-glass windows and serene atmosphere. Next, head to St. Thomas Mount for stunning views of the coastline. Finally, explore Marina Beach, one of the longest urban beaches, and enjoy the local scene. Return to the hotel for dinner. Overnight in Chennai.

DAY 12: CHENNAI TO VELANKANNI

After breakfast, take a scenic drive along the Coromandel Coast to Velankanni, known as the "Lourdes of the East." Check in to your hotel and visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Good Health, a significant Marian pilgrimage site with stunning Gothic architecture. According to legend, the Virgin Mary appeared here in the 16th century, healing the sick and blessing sailors. In the evening, attend a special Mass or enjoy the

spiritual atmosphere with fellow pilgrims. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight in Velankanni.

DAY 13: VELANKANNI TO MADURAI

After breakfast, travel to Madurai, one of India's oldest cities, and check into your hotel. Visit the magnificent Meenakshi Temple, famous for its colorful gopurams and vibrant atmosphere. Next, explore the 17th-century Thirumalai Nayakkar Palace, known for its grand courtyards and intricate designs. End the day with a light and sound show about Madurai's history, followed by dinner and an overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 14: MADURAI TO GOA

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Goa. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and relax. Don't miss the Church of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception, with its beautiful white facade and bell tower. Spend the

evening wandering Goa's charming streets and local markets. Enjoy dinner at the hotel and stay overnight in Goa.

DAY 16: GOA TO COCHIN

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Cochin (Kochi). Upon arrival, check in at your hotel and then embark on a scenic houseboat cruise in Alleppey. Glide through coconut-fringed canals and lush paddy fields, enjoying fresh coconut water and an authentic Kerala-style lunch on board. In the evening, watch a captivating Kathakali dance performance depicting Hindu mythology. Dinner at the hotel and overnight in Cochin.

DAY 17: COCHIN TO TRIVANDRUM

After breakfast, take a scenic drive to Trivandrum, Kerala's capital, known for its royal heritage and beautiful beaches. Start at the stunning Padmanabhaswamy Temple, dedicated to Lord Vishnu, where you can admire its architecture from outside. Next, visit the Napier Museum, an Indo-Saracenic gem filled with Kerala's royal artifacts and textiles. Then head to Kovalam Beach to watch a beautiful sunset over the Arabian Sea. Spend the evening exploring local markets for souvenirs and traditional handicrafts before returning to the hotel for dinner. Overnight in Trivandrum.

DAY 18: DEPARTURE FROM TRIVANDRUM OR COCHIN
